Senior Health Insurance Program Pat Walker or another SHIP counselor will be here every Tuesday through Thursday from 1 to 4 PM. A SHIP counselor is trained and certified to help you navigate the Medicare system and to answer your questions about Medicare A, B, C, and D, Medicare Advantage, and supplemental plans. Pat can also help you make sense of your medical bills. Please call 644-3317 to book an appointment (required). Don't forget about Medicare Open Enrollment from October 15 to December 7 every year. This is your only time during the year when we can review your prescription drug plan – you might save money in January next year!
